


Ontario Universities Growing our Talent Pool



Ontario Universities Student Enrolment by Home Region






Ontario Universities are Graduating Job-Ready Students


MCU graduate survey results (2022)

Employment Income of Postsecondary Graduates, 2 Years After Graduation




